<u>Lesson Plan: Essentials of AV Technology</u> (Time Agenda: 5 Days – 20 Hours)

Audio/Video Essentials is a 20-hour course outlining the fundamentals of A/V technologies. This class starts with the basics of sound & hearing and light & vision, the building blocks of audio/video. We will then explore the math behind selecting the proper video display and calculating loudspeaker loads. The most current A/V connectivity options and the protocols which transmit these signals are presented. A/V controls and networking are discussed, along with the multiple phases of an audio/video project including site survey, design, installation, closeout, and system operation & training. The course will also encompass hands-on exercises allowing students to select and build components for functional signal paths. Ultimately, all participants will learn about A/V industry training and certifications and are strongly encouraged to explore further professional credentials. This course will prepare our workforce to be successful at completing relevant industry exams.
